Introduction

Versa CSX2000 series appliances are latest additions to Versa's family of software-defined Ethernet switching platforms. Versa CSX2000 series switching platforms are ideal for enterprise LAN edge and access deployments targeting small to mid size branch or campus network deployments. CSX2000 series switching platforms expand Versa's Secure SD-LAN portfolio further to cover broader set of needs, deployment scenarios, new price-performance points.

CSX2000 series switches combine best in class merchant Ethernet switch chipset for enterprise branch and campus networks, with its dedicated x86 based processor sub-system to deliver cutting edge Secure SD-LAN capabilities.

CSX2000 units are powered by VOS[™] (Versa Operating System) natively. The same VOS[™] that runs on WAN Edge, cloud edge deployments and on Enterprise class CSX4000, CSX8000 switching platforms, now runs on CSX2000 platforms, providing solid software foundation for SD Branch. Together with Versa Secure SD-WAN platforms, Versa Secure SD-LAN solutions, now with the addition of CSX2000 platforms, provide Software Defined Branch and Software Defined Campus solutions with embedded Layer4-7 security, SD-WAN, SD-LAN, ZTNA on-premises, IoT Security all in one.

Product Description

Versa CSX2000 series switching platforms deliver carrier-grade reliability, line-rate Ethernet switching, together with built-in x86 based compute for enterprise-grade routing, SD-LAN, on-premises ZTNA, inline device fingerprinting and identification, Software Defined Access and Software Defined LAN Perimeter capabilities.

Natively integrated security functions running on the CSX2000 based LAN Edge/ Access switch revolutionizes LAN solutions. Such capabilities ensure right level of granular access control, user and device authentication, microsegmentation, device classification and ZTNA functions implemented at the entry point to enterprise LAN. Applying such critical decisions at the entry point to LAN provides best device and user traffic management, traffic separation, policy based traffic management capabilities.

Versa Secure SD-LAN solution running on CSX2000 units support traditional L2, L3 forwarding. Versa recommends use of SDN based overlays to be used on uplink ports or connections to realize the full potential of Versa Secure SD-LAN solution.

Versa CSX2000 series platforms offer LAN edge/access and high-speed uplink ports to provide non-blocking, high performance LAN solution. CSX2000 switching ports are driven by best in class, feature-rich and highly scalable, market leading campus class Ethernet switch chipset from the leading merchant silicon vendor. Options of single-rate GE and multirate GE ports with built-in PoE++ capacities are available. CSX2000 LAN edge Ethernet switches offer different SKUs to provide single rate or multi-rate GE access ports to provide connectivity to other network elements in the LAN environment.

Furthermore, select SKUs of CSX2000 provide MACSEC at line rate across all of its ports to encrypt traffic in sensitive networks environments.

CSX2000 series switching platforms interoperate seamlessly with rest of CSX switching family products, CSX4000 and CSX8000 series forming enterprise class LAN solutions scaling from few switches all the way to hundreds or thousands of switches all working in harmony thanks to Versa's standard based highly scaleable SDN solutions, Versa Secure SD-LAN.

Product Details

Versa CSX2000 units come with 24 or 48 port LAN edge/access interfaces with PoE++ (90W), and 4 to 6 high speed interfaces consisting of 10GE SFP+ or SFP28 (10/25 GE) interfaces. CSX2000 units do not use proprietary cables or interfaces. All interfaces are standard based and they can be used for uplink or downlink or access or trunk purposes.

High performance switching ASIC is dedicated to driving all of these interfaces at line rate, while the switching ASIC is also connected with high-speed interfaces to high performance x86 complex that runs VOS while VOS provides Layer-4-7stateful services.

VOS based CSX2000 platforms have built-in intelligence to program embedded switch fabric to drive L2, L3, VXLAN, QoS, ACLs, MPLS, IPv4/v6, unicast/multicast and other functions at line rate across LAN interfaces. All traffic that is received by LAN interfaces will first be processed by the Ethernet switch and if the destination is another LAN port where no stateful functions need to be applied to the traffic, the traffic will be forwarded at line rate to destination port(s). If traffic needs to go through Layer-4-7 stateful processing for on-premises ZTNA, device fingerprinting, user/group level traffic management, advanced SD-Access or for other security or application intelligence purposes, these flows will be sent to x86 processor running VOS natively to be processed by VOS. VOS running on the x86 processing complex will pick flows and will process them seamlessly and hand off to LAN interfaces depending on traffic destinations and intent defined by policies. One needs to ensure that desired security, application intelligence or other services remain within the processing envelope of the x86 processing complex.

All stateless and stateful processing and forwarding of flows will be handled intelligently within the platform seamlessly. Such intelligent processing allows our customers to benefit from best of both worlds; high performance line-rate forwarding for LAN traffic combined together with rich set of stateful functions for L4-L7 for targeted traffic profiles. The combination of seamless traffic handling and traffic management that combines performance with state opens doors for many new applications and use-cases that are unmatched in the market.

Built-in Layer-4-7 security, micro segmentation and software defined access with granular control on the LAN edge gives our customers the option to admit devices and users on right parts of the network, and secure their traffic in N-S and in E-W directions. With embedded security functions, Versa CSX2000 appliances enable secure, scalable and reliable enterprise-wide LAN networking solutions.
